

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



- Piling and ground works continue and are progressing well. AJ Morrisroe now have over 100 operatives on site.
- Progress is ongoing with piling the "secant" wall which will form the support to allow the new basement levels to be dug further down the line.
- This month we will start the large diameter piles that will form the new London underground ticket hall.
- We have continued to clear the old basement concrete from the site to clear the way for the new structure.
- We currently have two gates in use for construction vehicles entering and exiting the site. These are managed by teams of trained traffic marshals.

Candidates have now been interviewed by our concrete supply chain partner for the two Formwork Apprenticeship opportunities. The positions have been offered to those who were successful, with the first candidate commencing his apprenticeship on **Wednesday 13th April 2022,** and the second commencing his apprenticeship on **Wednesday 20th April**. We have hosted an additional work experience placement, taking our total to five to date.



WOMEN IN CONSTRUCTION

Members of the project team presented to a group of female construction students who are studying at The Skills Centre, in partnership with LSBU. During their visit they were given a detailed project overview before having the chance to engage with some members of the workforce and sit in an excavator.

Environmental Management

The project was audited by the Greater London Authority to ensure all plant and equipment is compliant with regulations relating to air quality. The project was deemed fully compliant and was issued a certificate of excellence.

Waste Management

The project is reusing desks, chairs, lockers and other furniture from other Multiplex projects to reduce waste and increase material efficiency.
