SITE ACTIVITY UPDATE

The current and upcoming site activities during April will be as follows:

- · Safe removal of hazardous material, including asbestos
- Realignment of the hoarding to the Northern Line Station exit
- · Preparation works for the link bridge removal
- Scaffold dismantling to the Coronet Theatre
- Ongoing soft strip operations in the Shopping Centre
- Scaffold erection to Hannibal House and North West corner of the Shopping Centre
- Continuous structural demolition to the South of Hannibal House

- Temporary works installation to the Coronet Theatre
- Structural demolition of the Coronet Theatre Projector Tower
- Commencement of specialist magnetometer probing
- Rerouting of dry dropper next to Northern Line Station
- Commencement of pile probing
- Partial removal of the Northern Line Station canopy

HIGH REACH DEMOLITION STARTS

Structural demolition of the Shopping Centre south of Hannibal House has commenced. The work is being carried out with a 50T high reach 360o demolition excavator fitted with a pulveriser attachment.

The demolition of this area will provide a logistics zone for a crane to assist the scaffold erection and structural demolition of Hannibal House.

SOCIAL VALUE SUSTAINABILITY IN CONSTRUCTION
