

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- AJ Morrisroe are undertaking the ground and piling works and they currently have over 100 operatives.
- Since the last newsletter we have started piling the "secant" wall which will form the support to allow the new basement levels to be dug at a later date.
- We have continued to clear the old basement concrete from the site to clear the way for the new structure.
- The smaller piling rig that has been putting in temporary piles that support the existing railway and pavement structures is now completed.
- We currently have 2 gates in use for construction vehicles entering and exiting the site. These are managed by teams of trained traffic marshals.

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY UPDATE

Environmental Management

Regular site inspections, toolbox talks and training sessions have taken place since the beginning of the year. A particular focus is to ensure zero environmental incidents occur on the project.

Carbon Reduction

As part of the design of the development, more sustainable concrete mixes have been specified where possible. These concrete mixes have a reduced Portland cement content which helps to reduce the carbon emissions of the material.

Waste management

To date, 100% of the construction waste generated on the project has been diverted from landfill. This goes beyond the project overall target of 99%.
