SITE ACTIVITY UPDATE

The upcoming site activities during December will be as follows:

- Completion of structural demolition to the Coronet Theatre flank wall adjacent Network Rail Platform 1
- · Completion of the crushing of demolition arisings
- Backfilling of the remaining released areas with crushed concrete

Following the completion of the contracted works, Keltbray will be handing over to Multiplex for the next phase of the development.

KELTBRAY DEMOLITION & ENABLING WORKS TIMELINE

Keltbray took possession of the Shopping Centre and surrounding buildings.

Shopping Centre north demolished.
Structural demolition of the Coronet
Theatre and Shopping Centre south nearing completion. Hannibal House demolition and pile probing has commenced.

Demolition arisings crushed and site backfilled. Retained areas adjacent Network Rail station demolished. Handover to Multiplex for follow-on development works.



Demolition of Charlie Chaplin pub, dentist, newsagents, front cinema structure and townhouses complete. Structural demolition complete to Hannibal House and Shopping Centre south. All Stage 1 props installed. Crushing of demolition and backfilling ongoing.

UPDATE FROM TRANSPORT FOR LONDON ON NORTHERN LINE AT ELEPHANT AND CASTLE

The Northern line (Bank branch) will be closed between Kennington and Moorgate from 15 January to mid-May 2022. This is due to work TfL are doing to substantially improve the capacity at Bank station. During the closure there will be no Northern line at four stations: Bank, London Bridge, Borough and Elephant & Castle.

To help people travel:

- TfL will run more frequent trains on the Charing Cross branch of the Northern Line
- Provide more buses, with a temporary new route from Oval into the City (route 733)


