

MULTIPLEX CONSTRUCTION PHASE & ENABLING WORKS TIMELINE



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- Multiplex construction are now Principle Contractor on the new Elephant & Castle Town Centre Development.
- Since taking over the site Multiplex have set up the new welfare and office facilities and now have 15 permanent members of the site team based there every day.
- We have also mobilised our ground works contractor AJ Morrisroe and they currently have over 20 operatives on site and are bringing in new machinery every day in preparation for the first construction activities.
- Over the next 4 weeks we will be preparing the site for concrete piling the first major construction
 activity. This will involve levelling and compacting the ground for the piling rigs and demolishing the
 basement slab to allow the piles to be drilled to their full depth of 50m.
- There is also a team of archaeologists on the site who are working for the Museum of London to see if they can find the remains of an old playhouse that was on the land during the 16th century.

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY UPDATE

Environmental Management

Following the Multiplex take-over of the site, the project team is currently building in the Multiplex Environmental Management System into the project. This focuses on minimising environmental risks and maximising environmental opportunities.

Building-in Sustainability:

Sustainability will be built in to the project through achieving the following sustainability assessments:

- BREEAM 2014 Very Good for the leisure spaces
- BREEAM 2014 Excellent for the offices, retail and education spaces

The Design Stage assessments have been submitted.

Project Sustainability Targets:

The project also has a range of other sustainability targets including the diversion of over 99% of construction waste from landfill. Key aspects of Multiplex's Decarbonisation Roadmap – One Decade to Act will be implemented.
